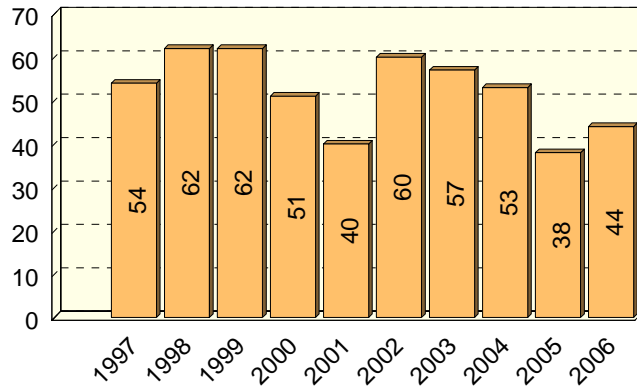

UPPER PENINSULA DEATHS

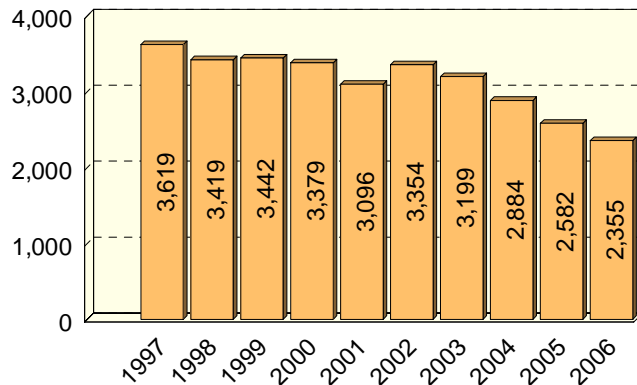
Number of Deaths



In 2006, 44 people died in motor vehicle crashes in the Upper Peninsula, a decrease of 18.5 percent from 1997.

UPPER PENINSULA INJURIES

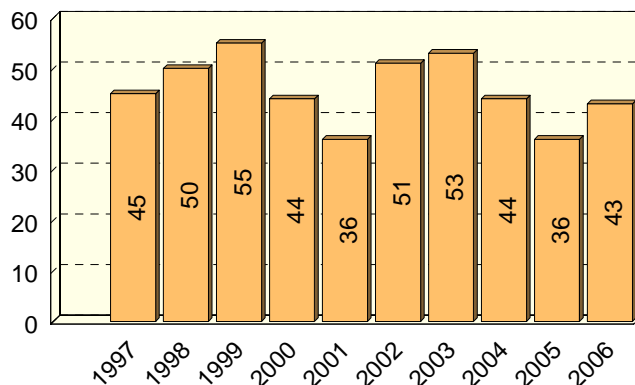
Number of Injuries



2,355 people received nonfatal injuries in Upper Peninsula motor vehicle crashes in 2006, down 34.9 percent from 3,619 in 1997.

UPPER PENINSULA FATAL CRASHES

In 2006, there were 43 fatal crashes in the Upper Peninsula, down 4.4 percent from 45 in 1997.
