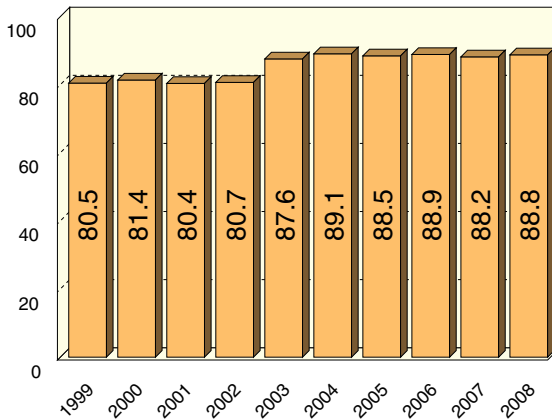




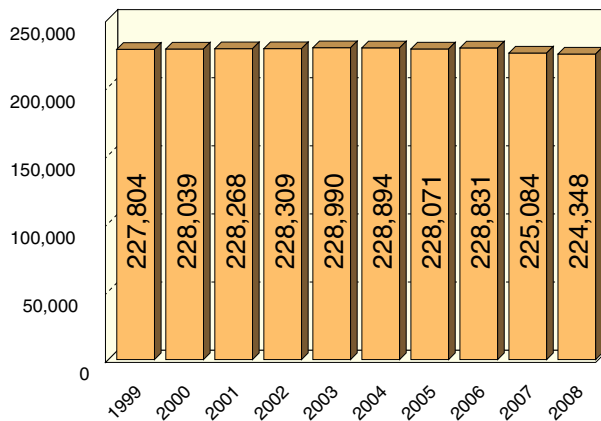

UPPER PENINSULA RESTRAINT USAGE



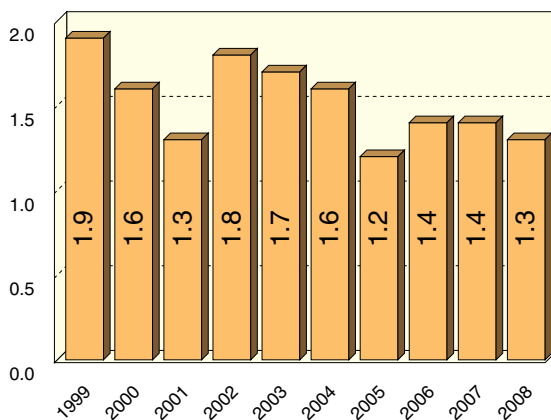
The percentage of motor vehicle occupants using restraints as reported by police in traffic crashes increased dramatically following implementation of seat belt law in July 1985. Restraint usage has increased 10.3 percent over the last ten years in the Upper Peninsula.

UPPER PENINSULA DRIVERS



There were 224,348 licensed drivers on Upper Peninsula roadways in 2008, a 1.5 percent decrease from 1999.

UPPER PENINSULA MILEAGE DEATH RATE



The 1.3 death rate for the Upper Peninsula in 2008 is a 31.6 percent decrease from 1.9 in 1999.
