NOTE: These crashes involve a motor vehicle in transport on a public trafficway and result in injury, death, or at least \$1,000 in property damage.

A total of 53 snowmobiles were reported in crashes on Upper Peninsula public roadways during 2009. Eight of these snowmobiles were involved in fatal crashes, with four operators of the snowmobiles killed. Six of the eight snowmobiles involved in fatal crashes were in the same multiple-snowmobile event, with two operators of those snowmobiles killed. The remaining two operators killed were in single vehicle crashes and both of those drivers had been drinking. An additional 33 snowmobiles were involved in injury crashes.
